
Once upon a time, there was a haughty king named Leo. King Leo was very proud and always thought he was the best. He would brag about his riches and his grand castle.

King Leo was scared and didn't know what to do. He tried to stop the water, but it was too much for him.



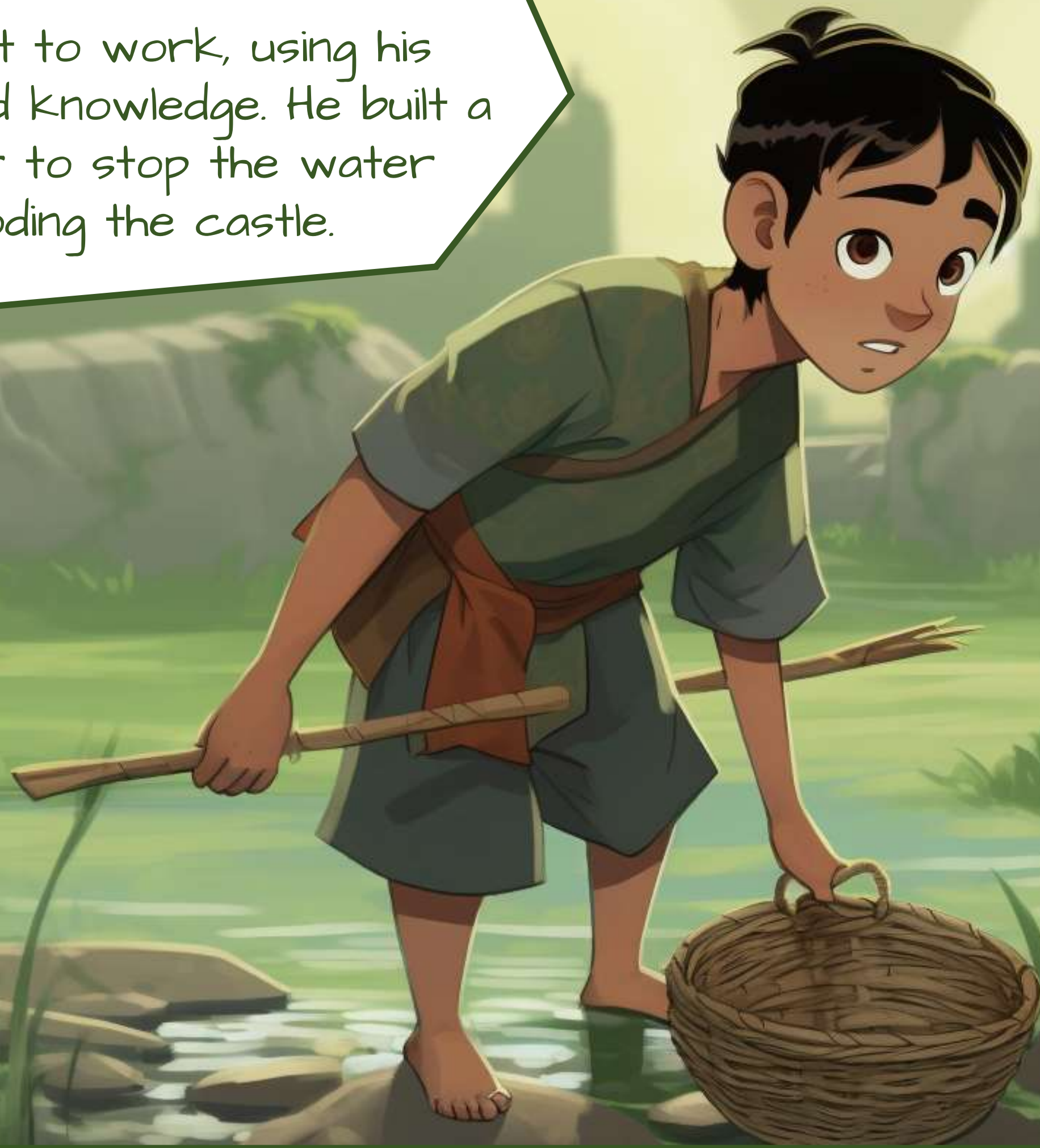
King Leo sent his knights to find Tim

Tim smiled kindly and said, "Yes, Your Majesty. It's important to help each other, no matter who we are."



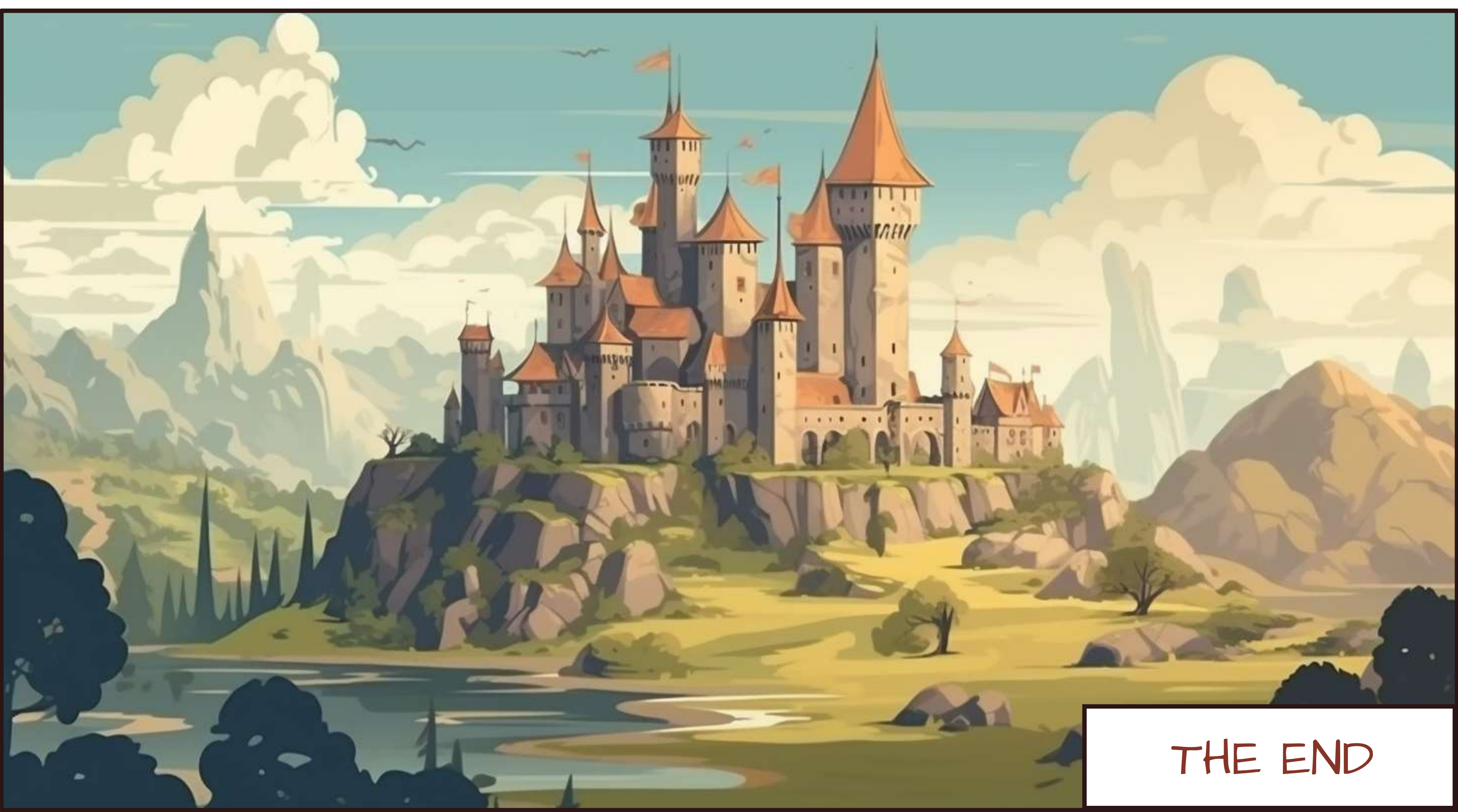
From that day on, King Leo became a kind and humble ruler. He treated everyone with respect and helped those in need.
