big wings.



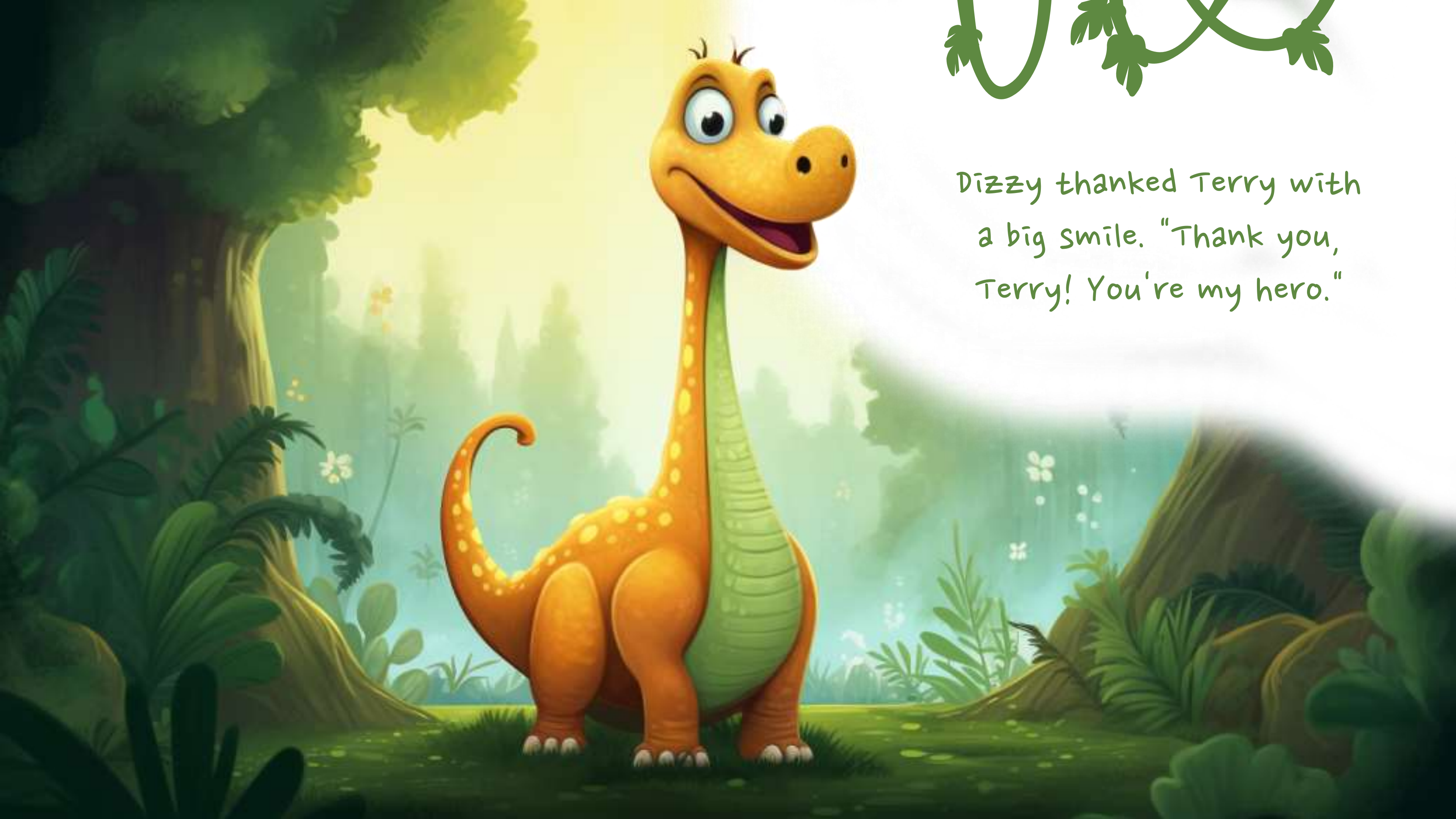
He spotted Dizzy's family
