

This enchanting children's fairy tale is a magical fantasy with valuable life lessons, so remember, it's all just pretend and enjoy the journey with parental guidance


Long ago in

and Taro enjoyed playing with animals.






one sunny day, Hiro drew a colorful picture of the mountains. Kenji saw it and said, "wow, Hiro, that's amazing!"

with a smile.




kenji added,
