inventions had good outcomes.



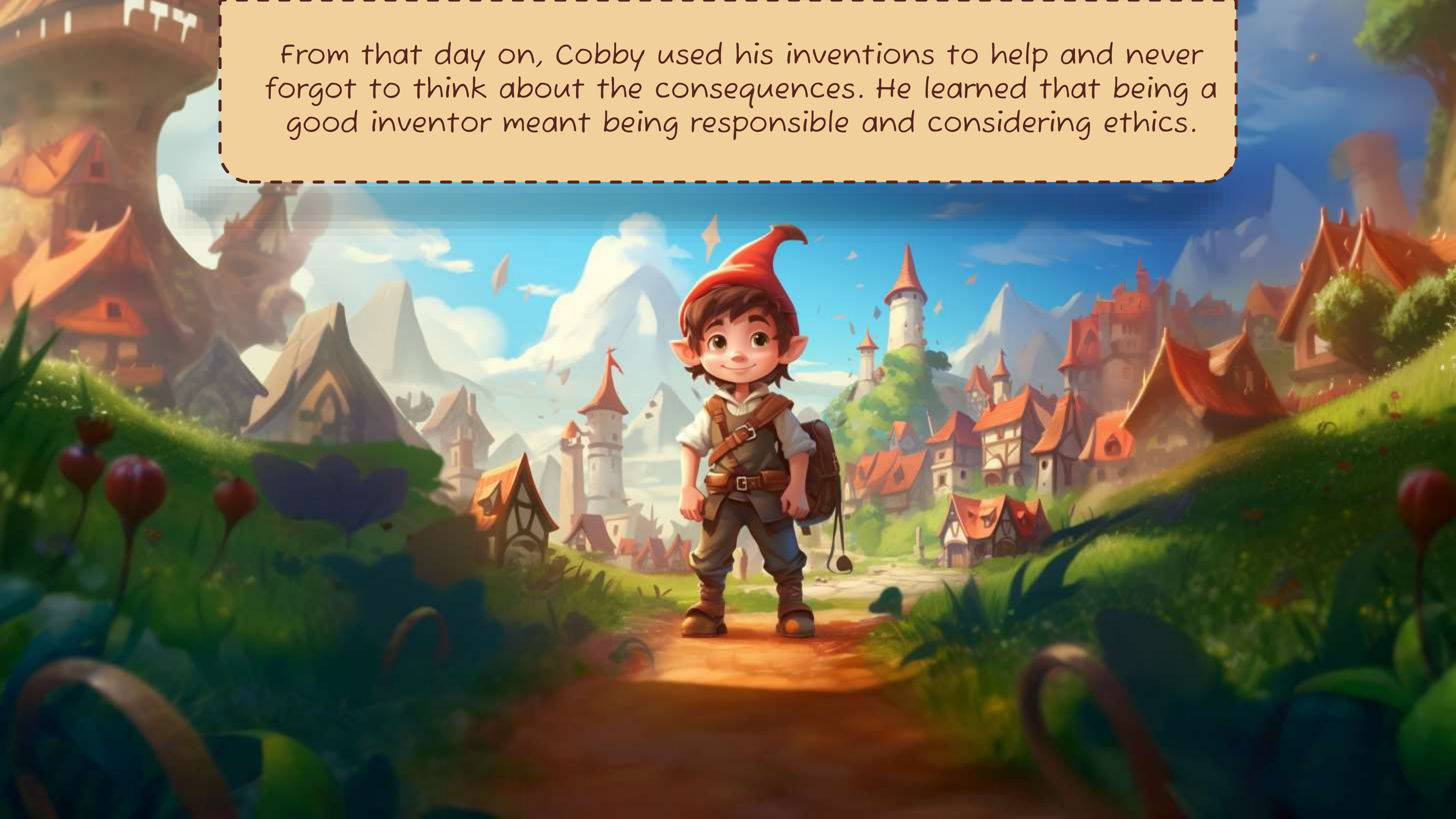


He felt sad and realized the importance of responsibility. Cobby decided to fix the flying contraption and apologize to the birds.
