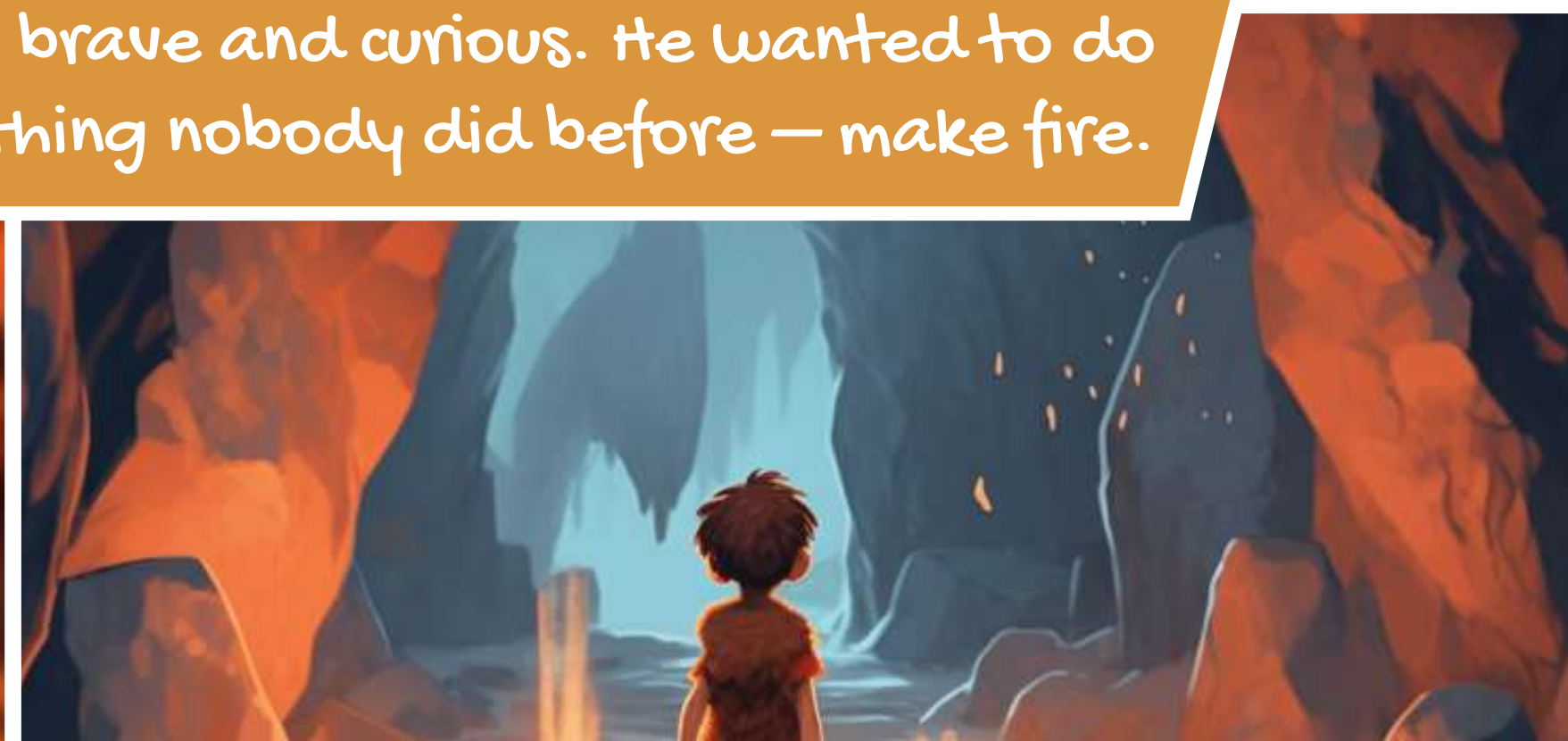




This enchanting children's fairy tale is a magical fantasy with valuable life lessons, so remember, it's all just pretend and enjoy the journey with parental guidance

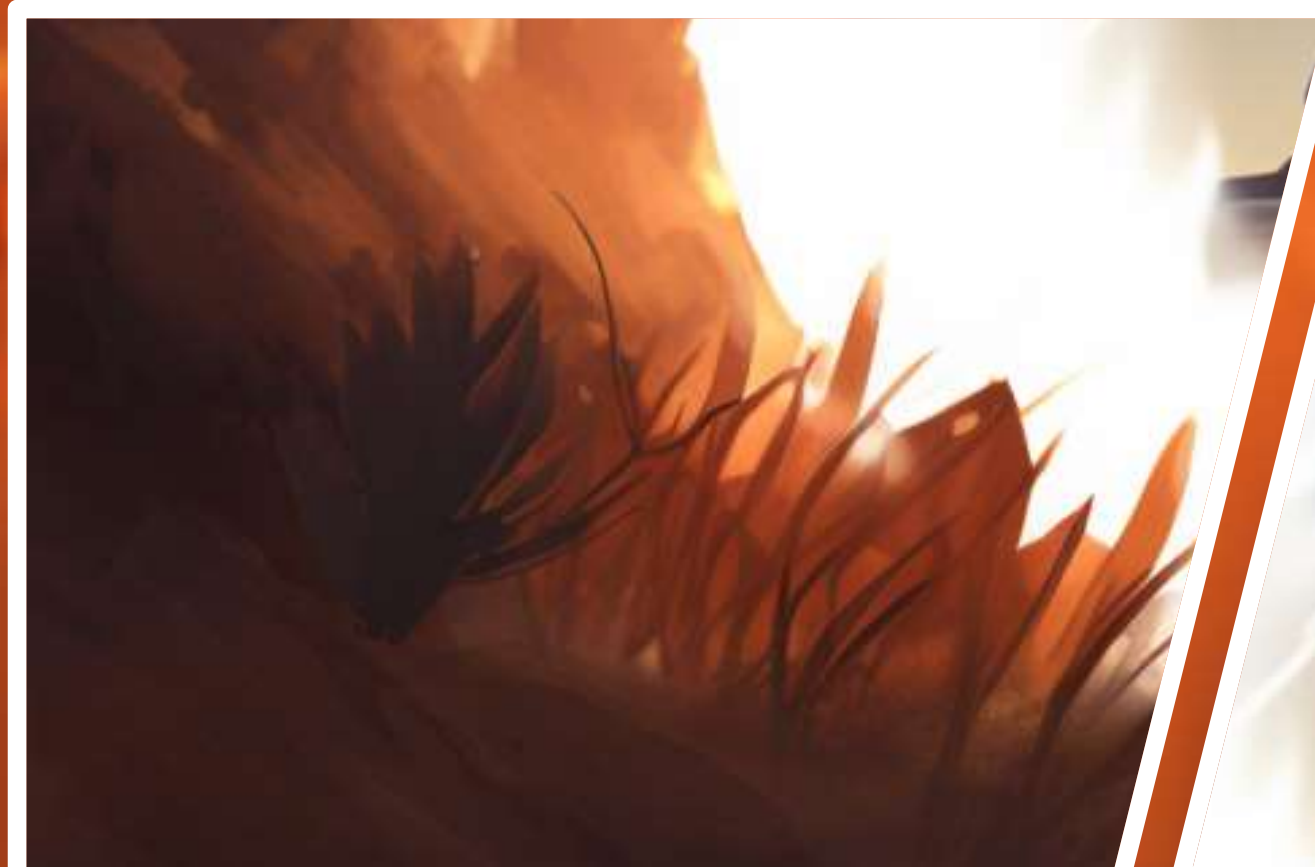
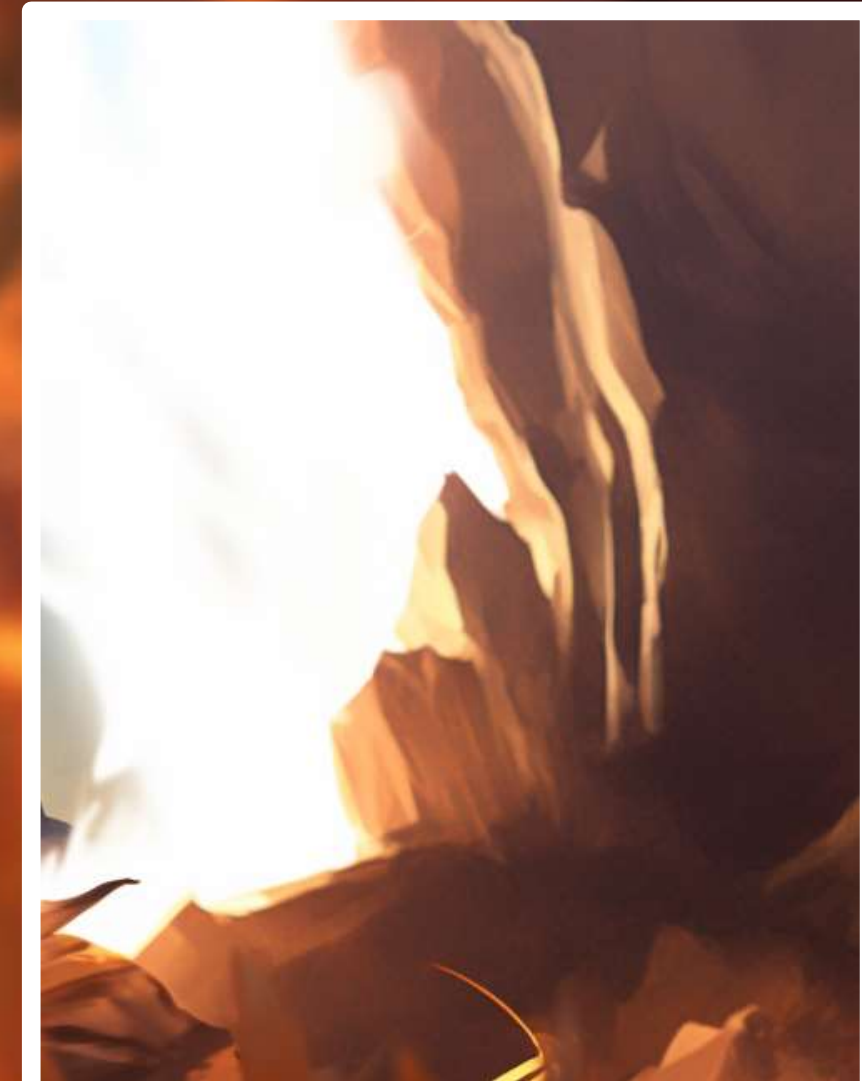




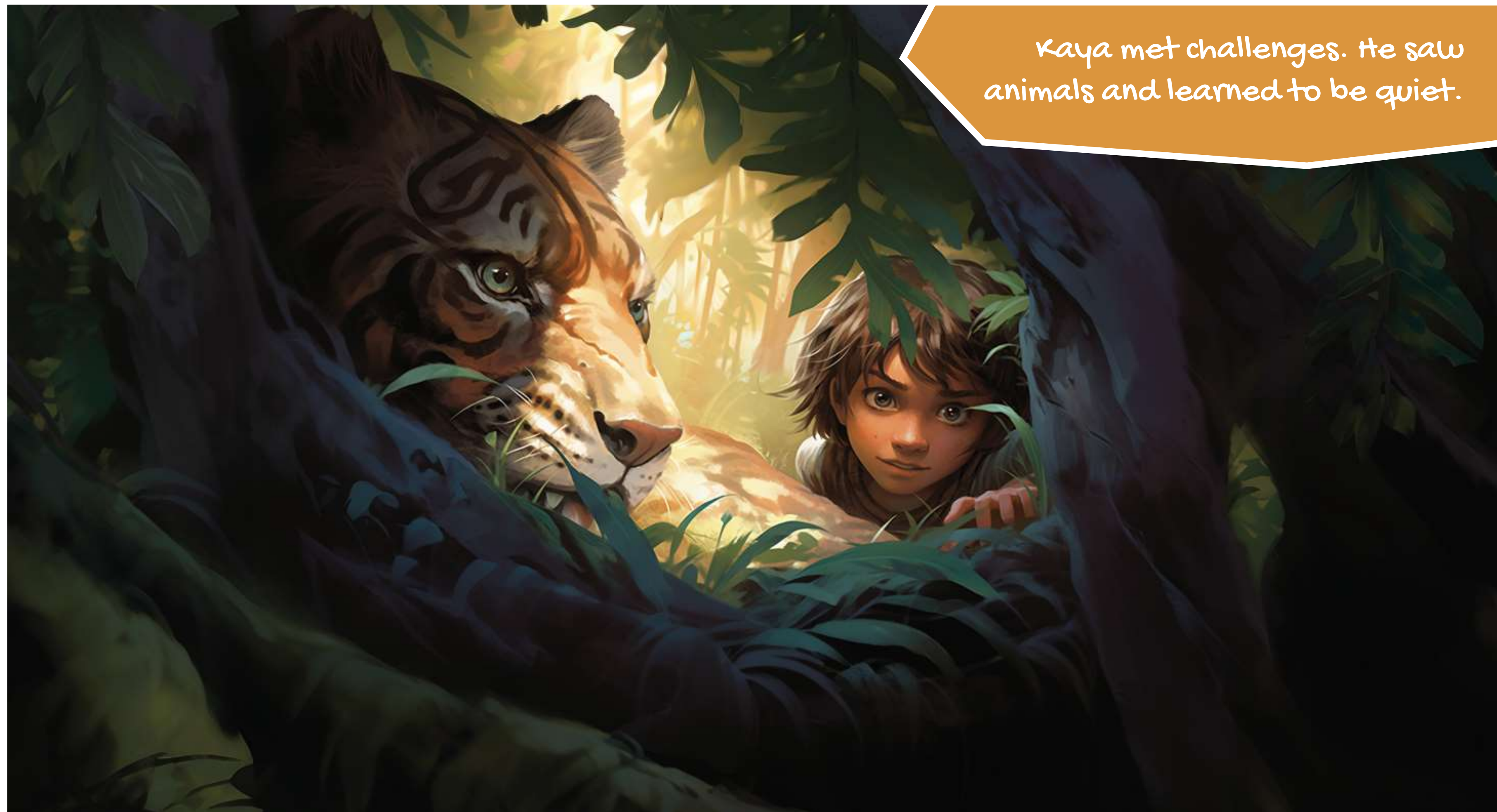
In Kaya's tribe, fire was special and came from lightning or the hot sun. But Kaya believed he could make fire himself.

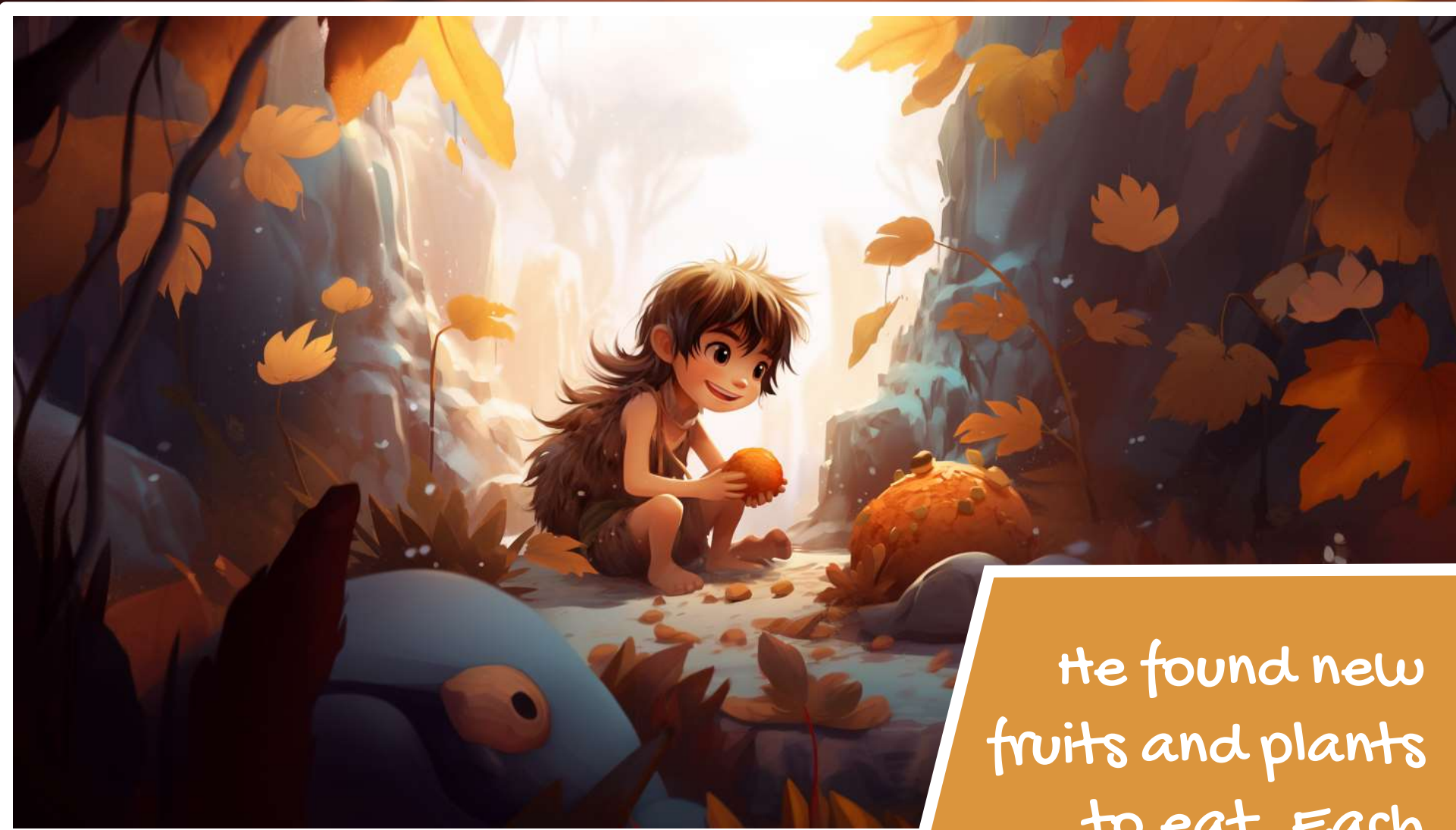

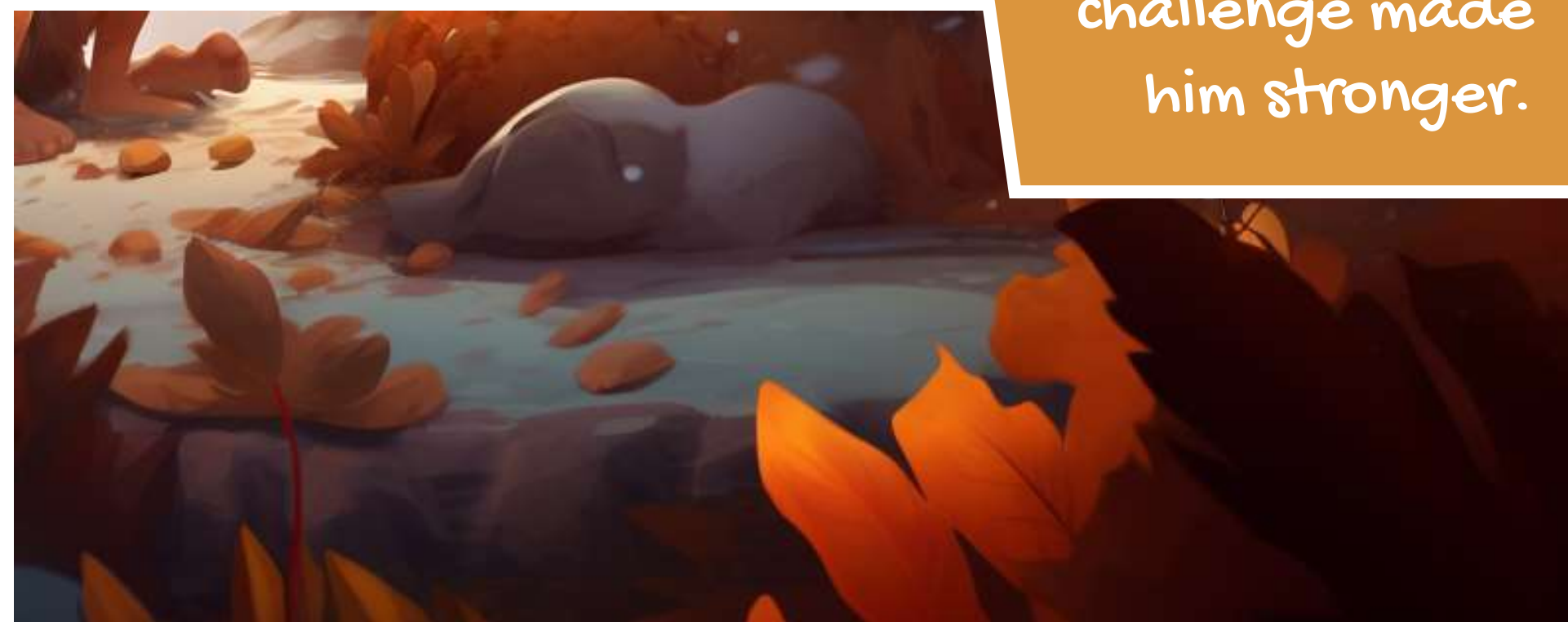


Kaya met challenges. He saw animals and learned to be quiet.



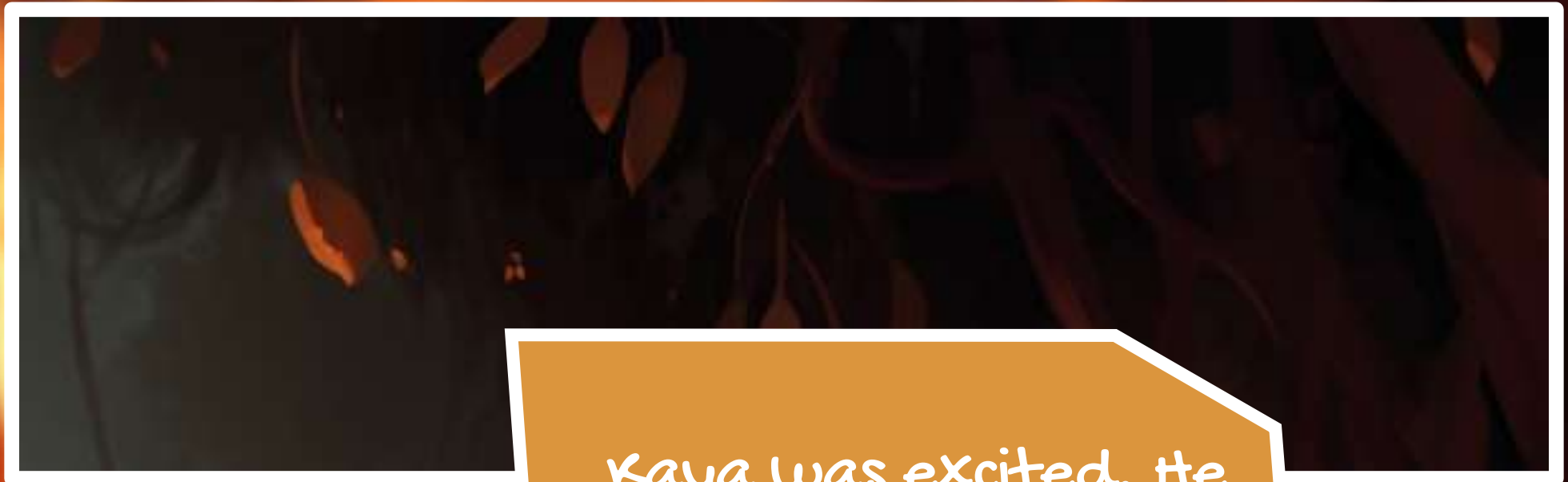


He found new

One sunny day, Kaya found a shiny rock called flint. It could make sparks when hit with another rock.



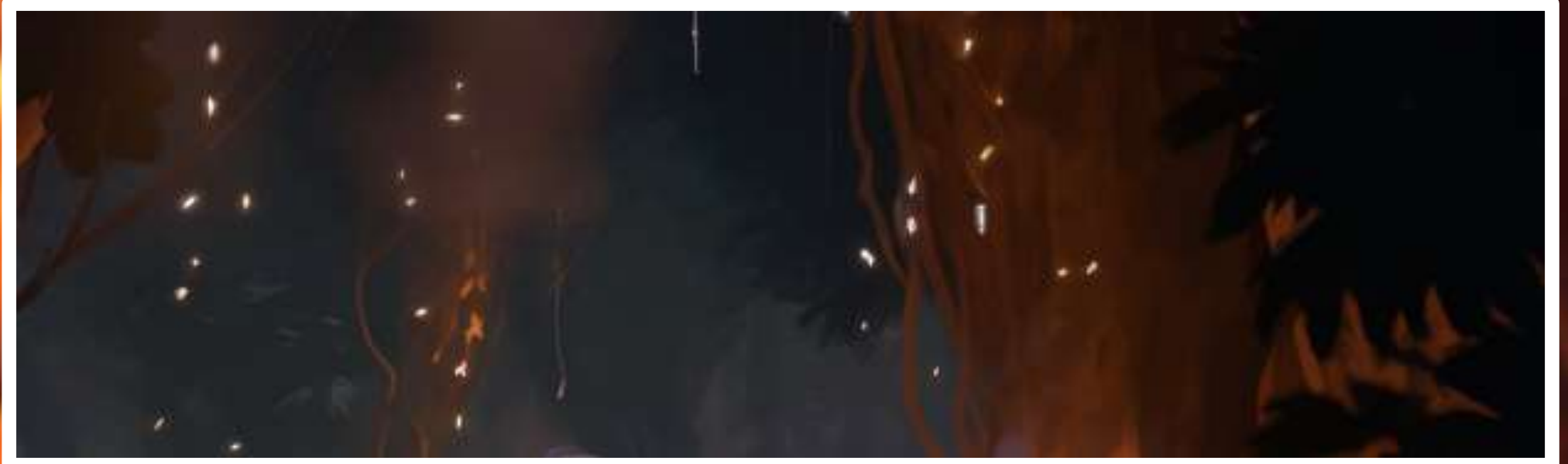
Kaya was excited. He picked the flint and tried. Sparks came. With dry leaves and sticks, he blew on the sparks. Fire started to burn!

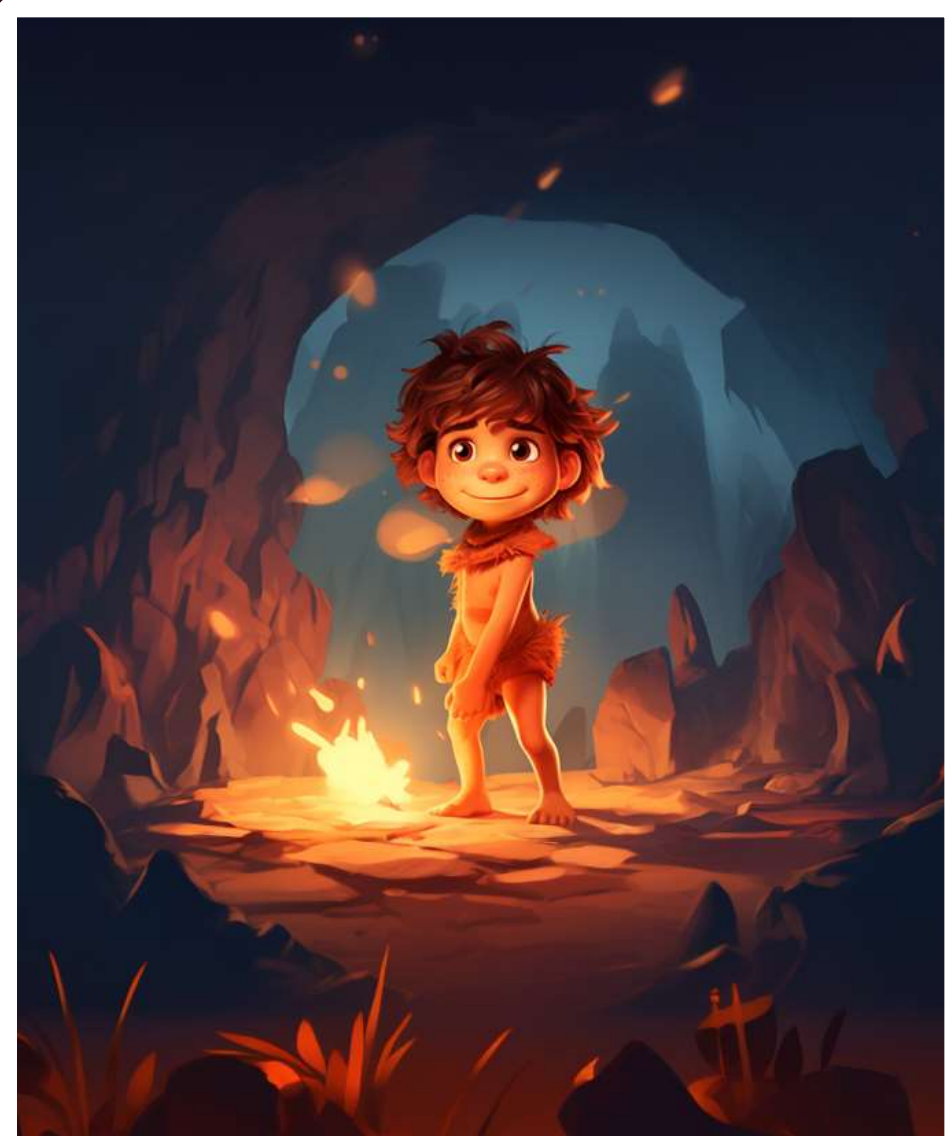




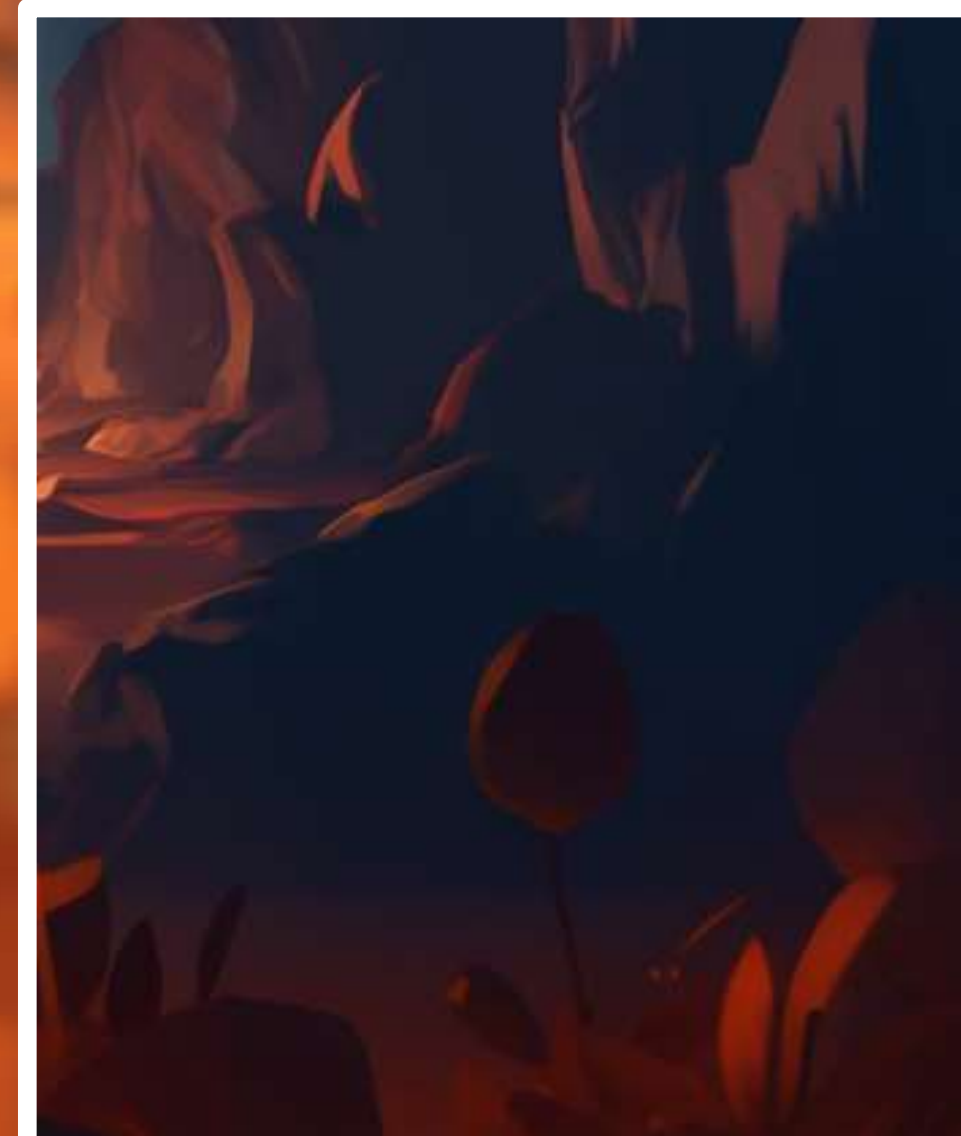
Kaya was so
