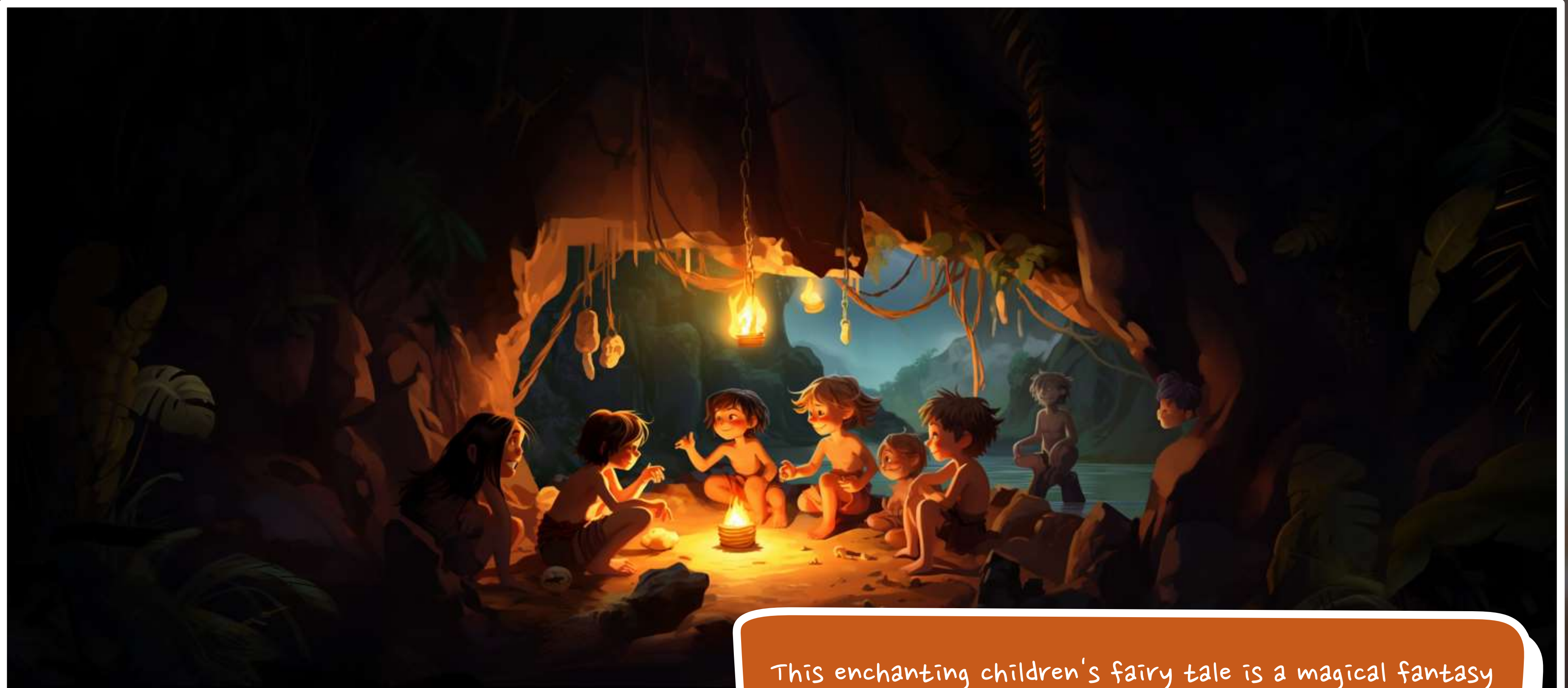

The First Prehistoric Feast

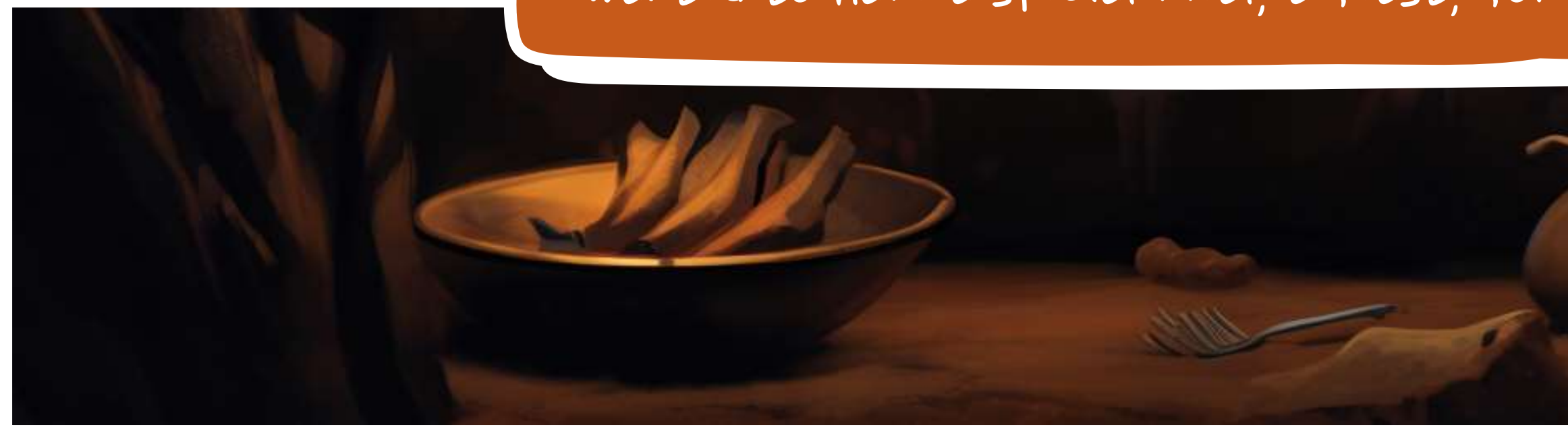


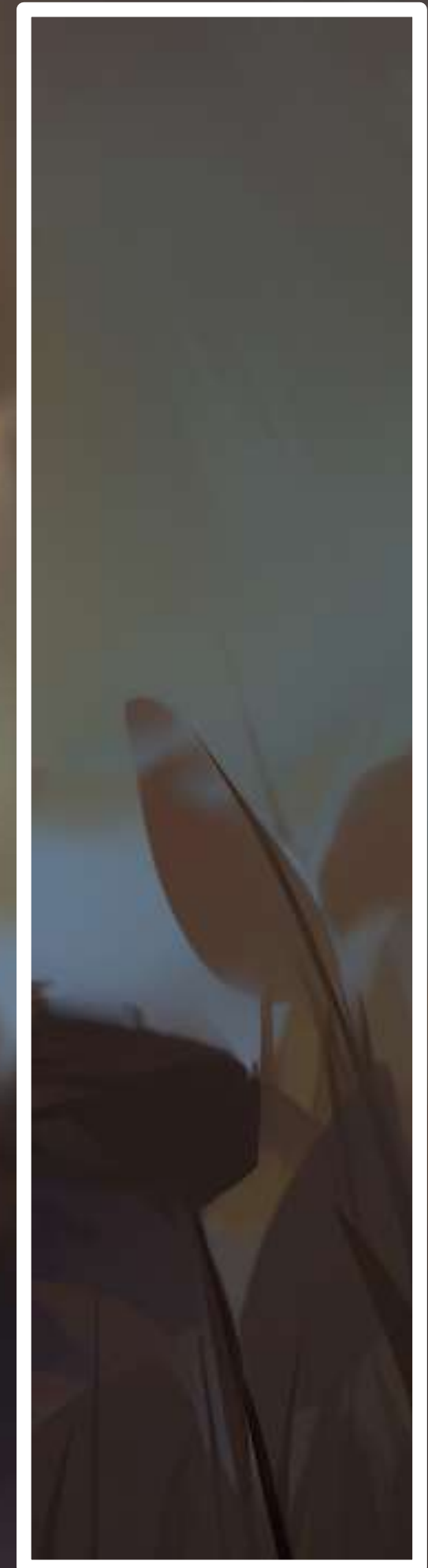
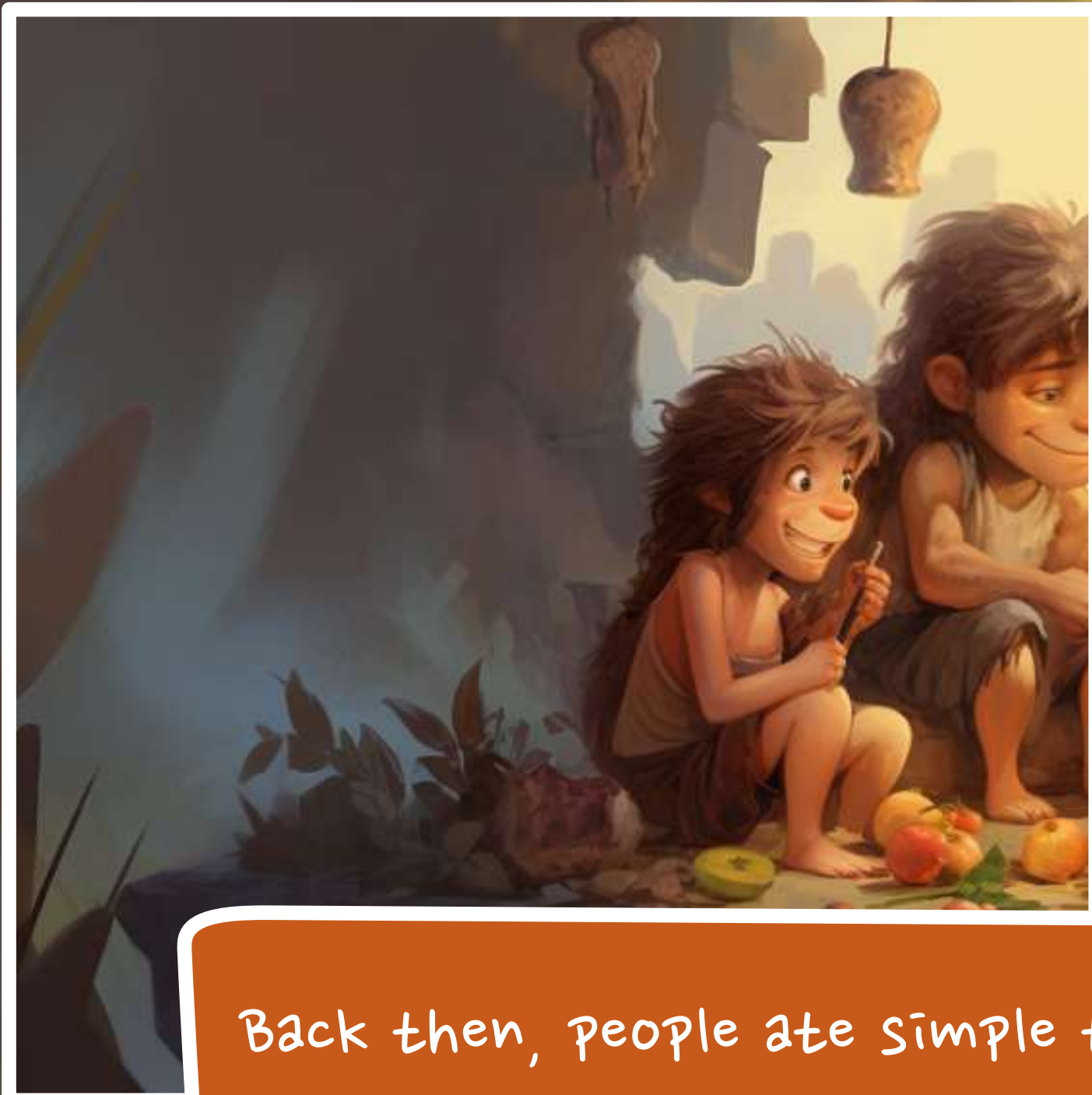


This enchanting children's fairy tale is a magical fantasy with valuable life lessons, so remember, it's all just pretend and enjoy the journey with parental guidance



A long, long time ago, when things were very different, a young caveboy named Tor had a big idea. He wanted to have a special meal, a feast, for his tribe.





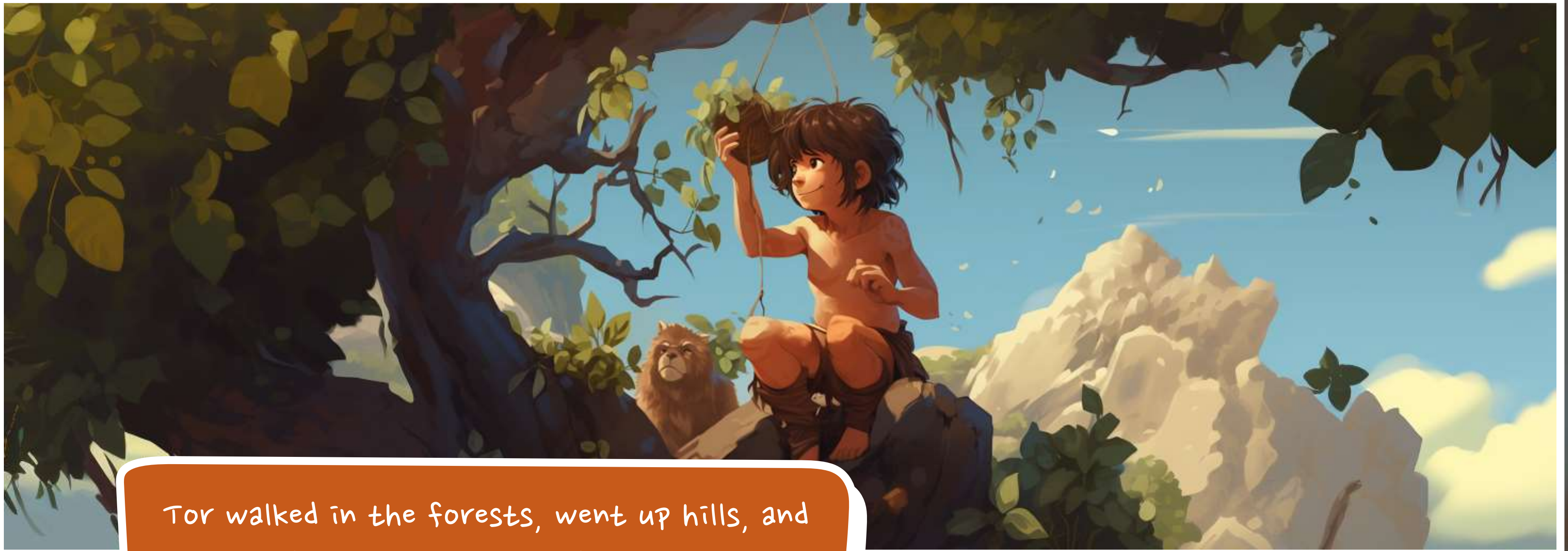
Back then, people ate simple things like fruits, nuts, and plants.



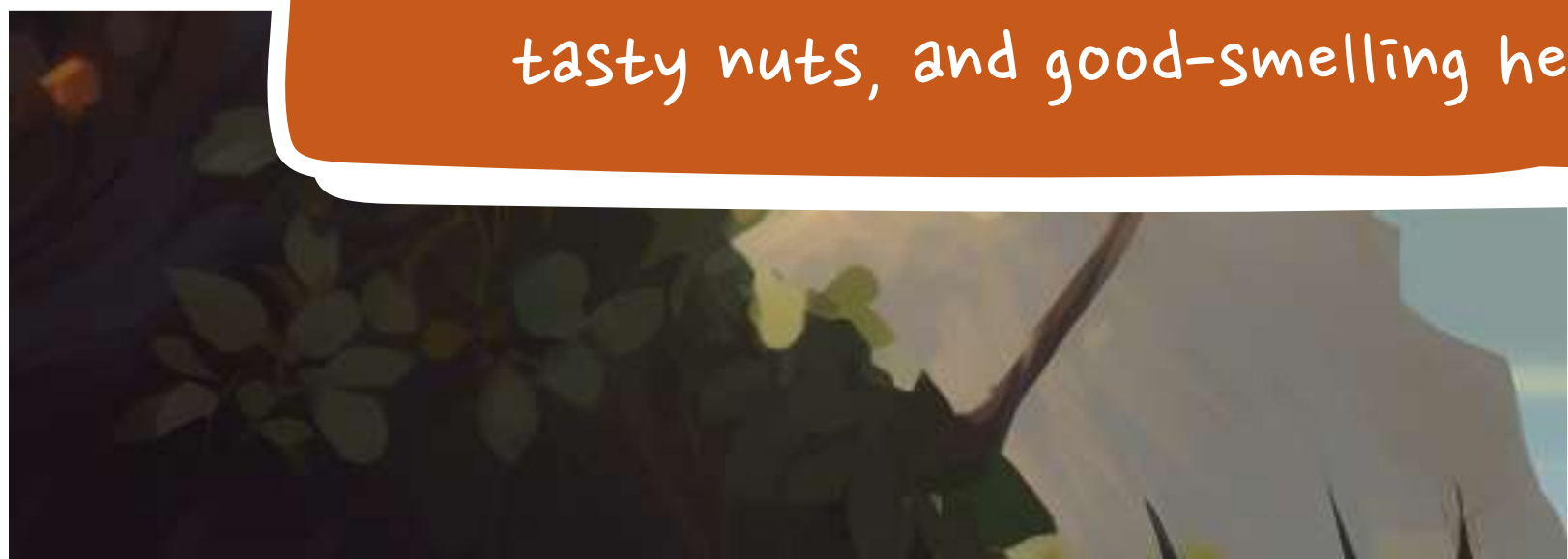


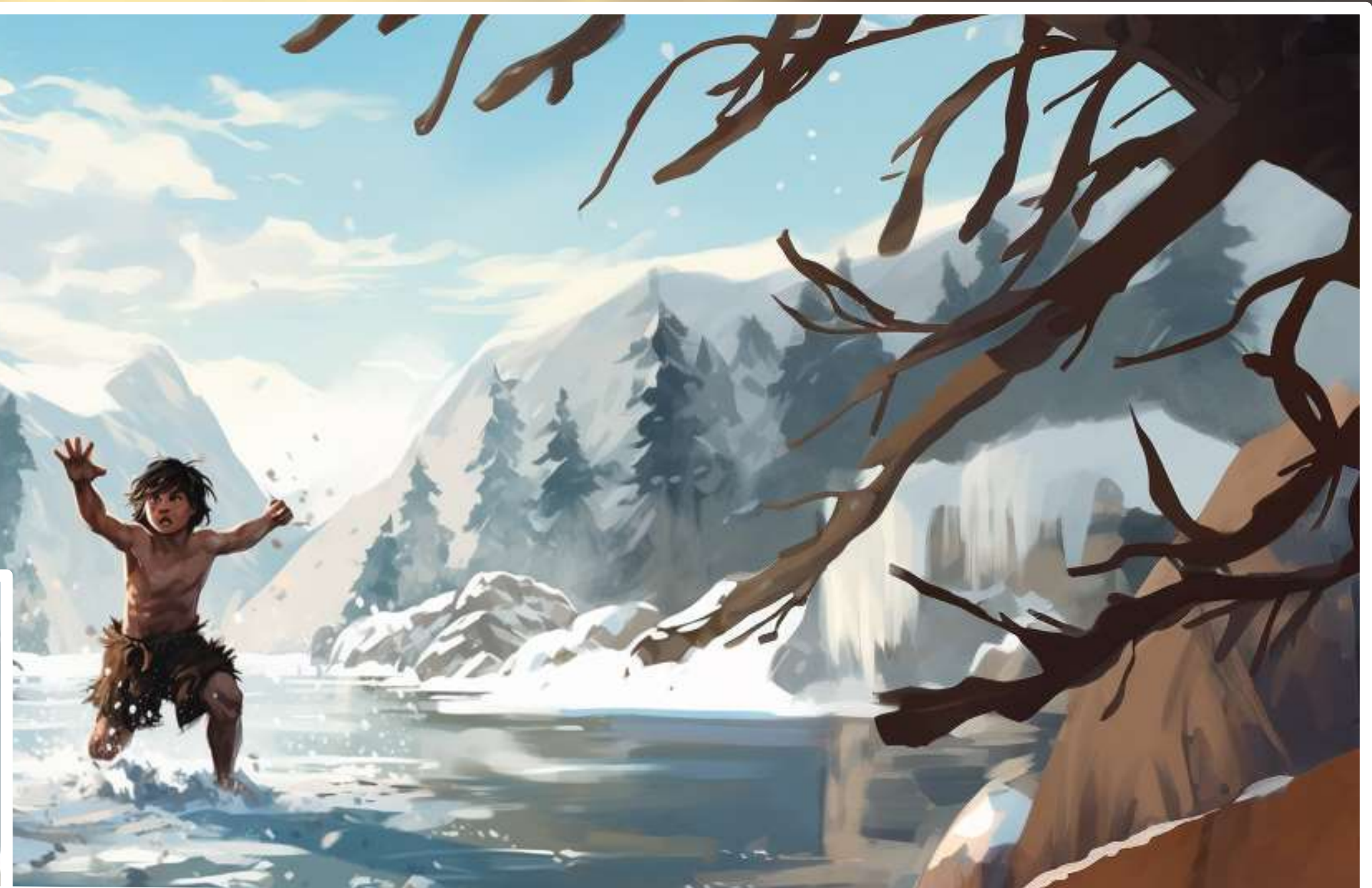
But Tor wanted to find more delicious things to eat.
He decided to go on an adventure to find new foods.



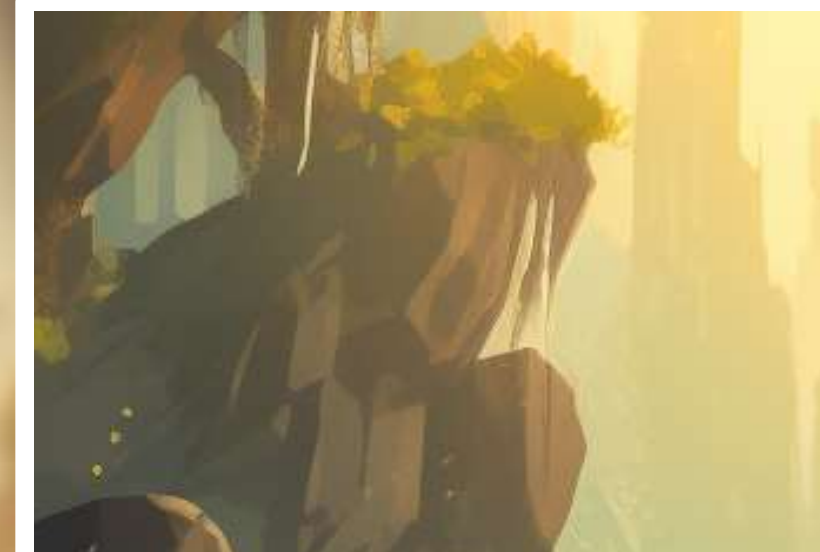


Tor walked in the forests, went up hills, and followed the river. He found sweet fruits, tasty nuts, and good-smelling herbs.



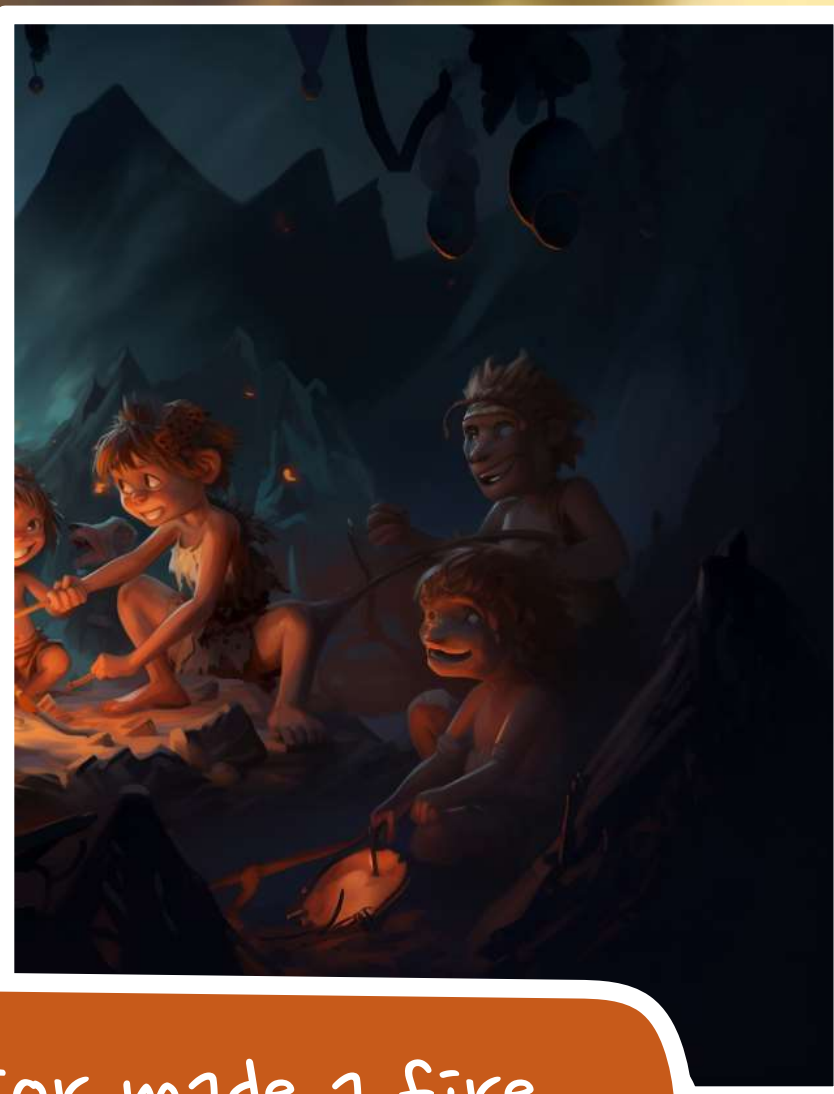
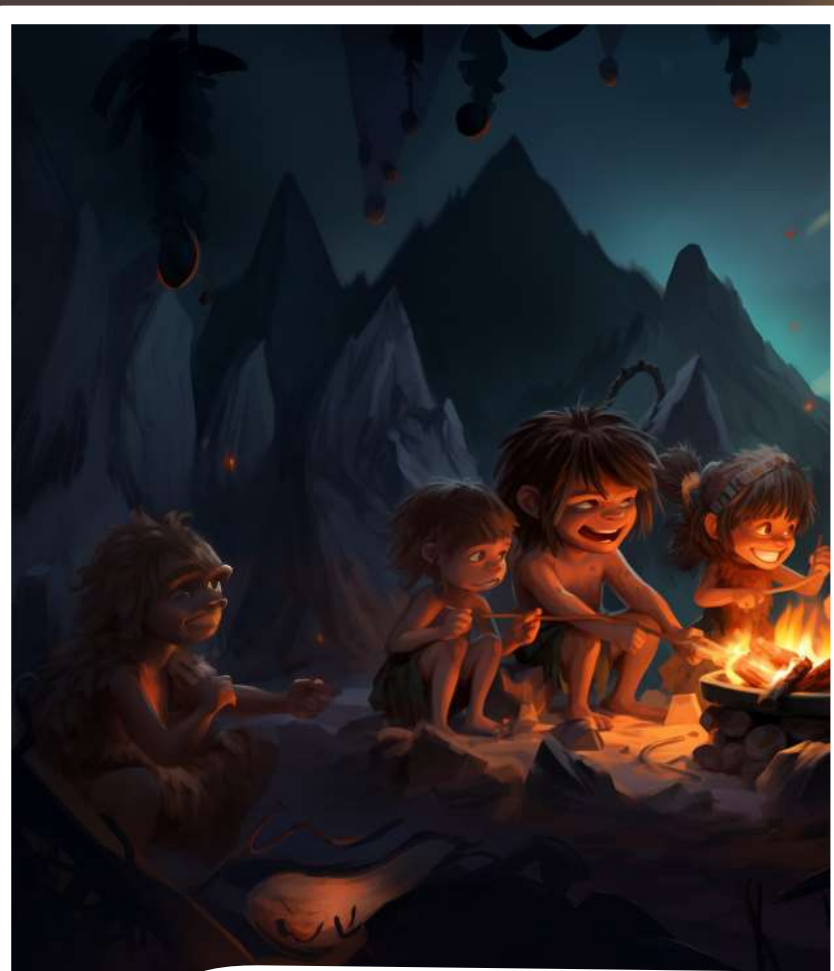


He also learned how to catch fish

getting their food.

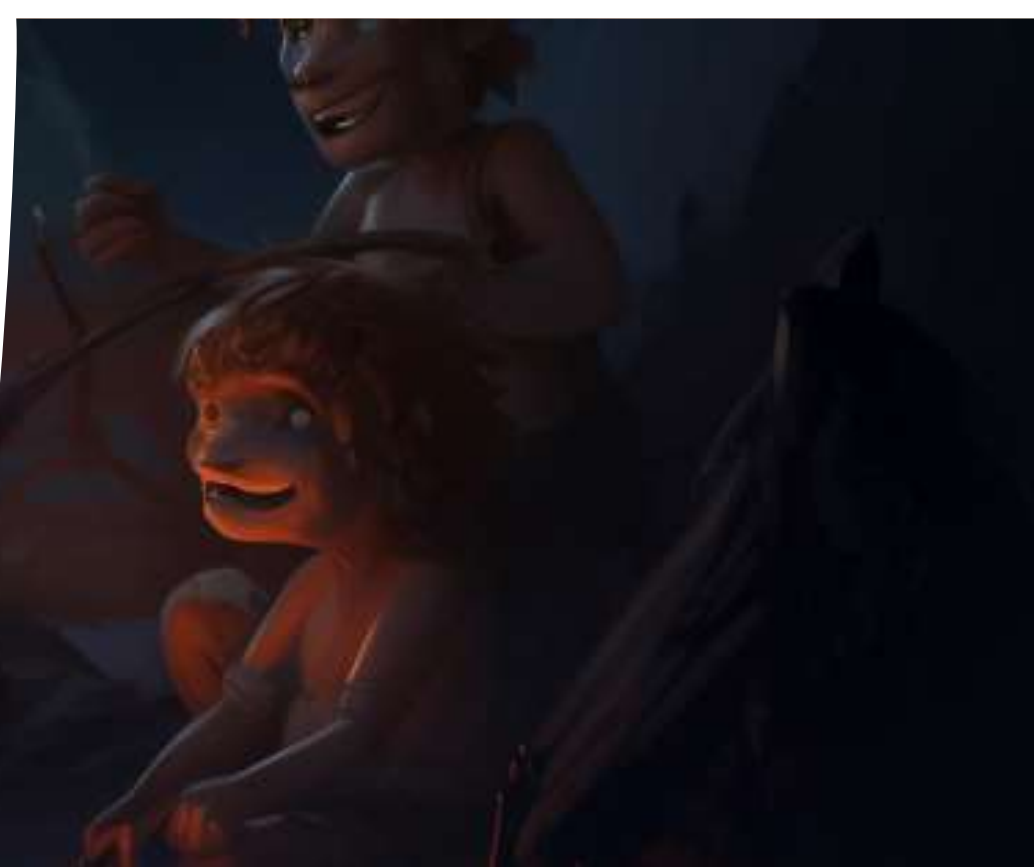


After some time, Tor came back to his tribe. He showed them the new foods he found. Everyone was happy and excited.





With his tribe, Tor made a fire. They cooked fish, roasted nuts, and had a yummy dessert with the new fruits. The tribe felt happy and close together.

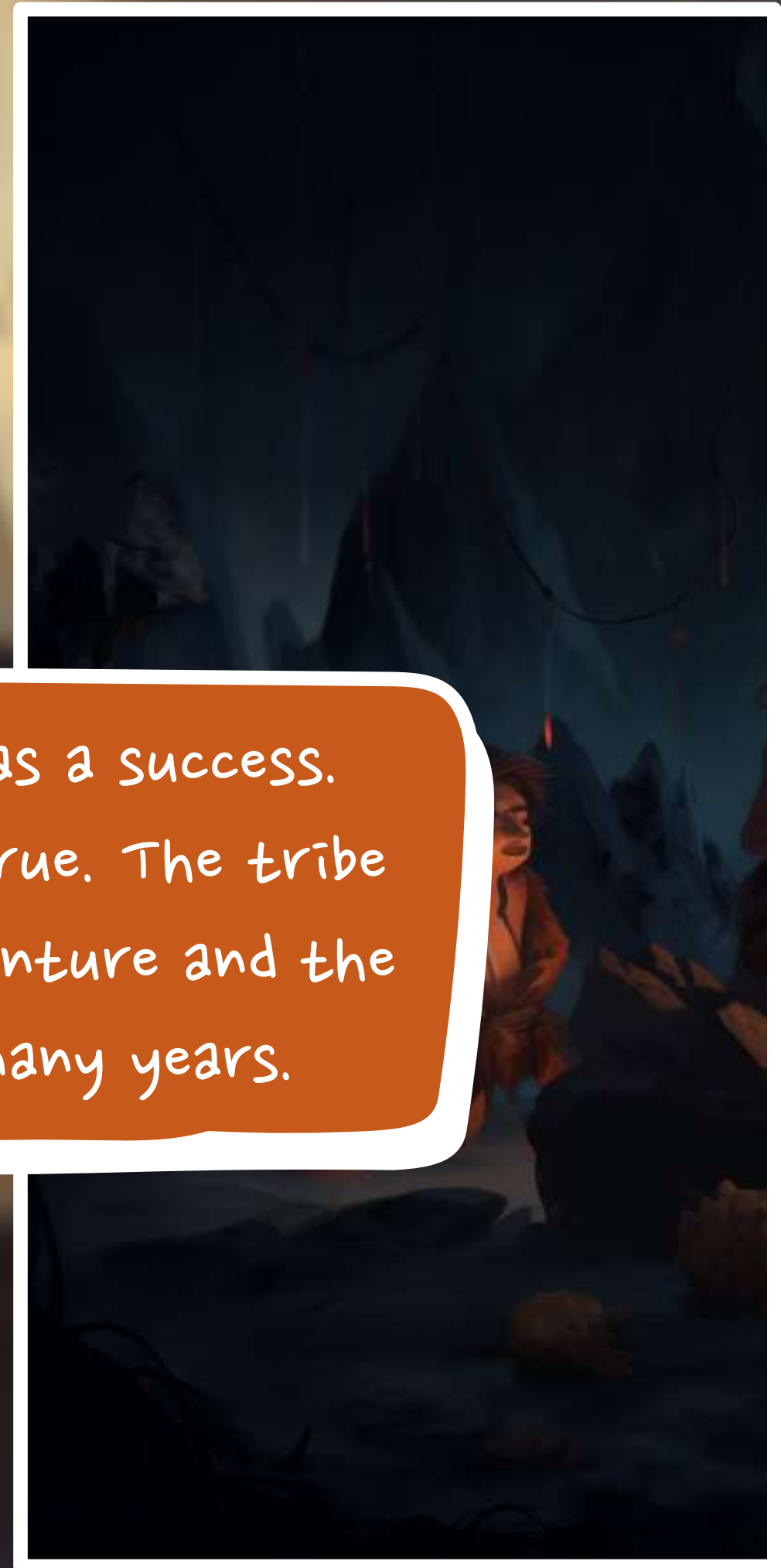
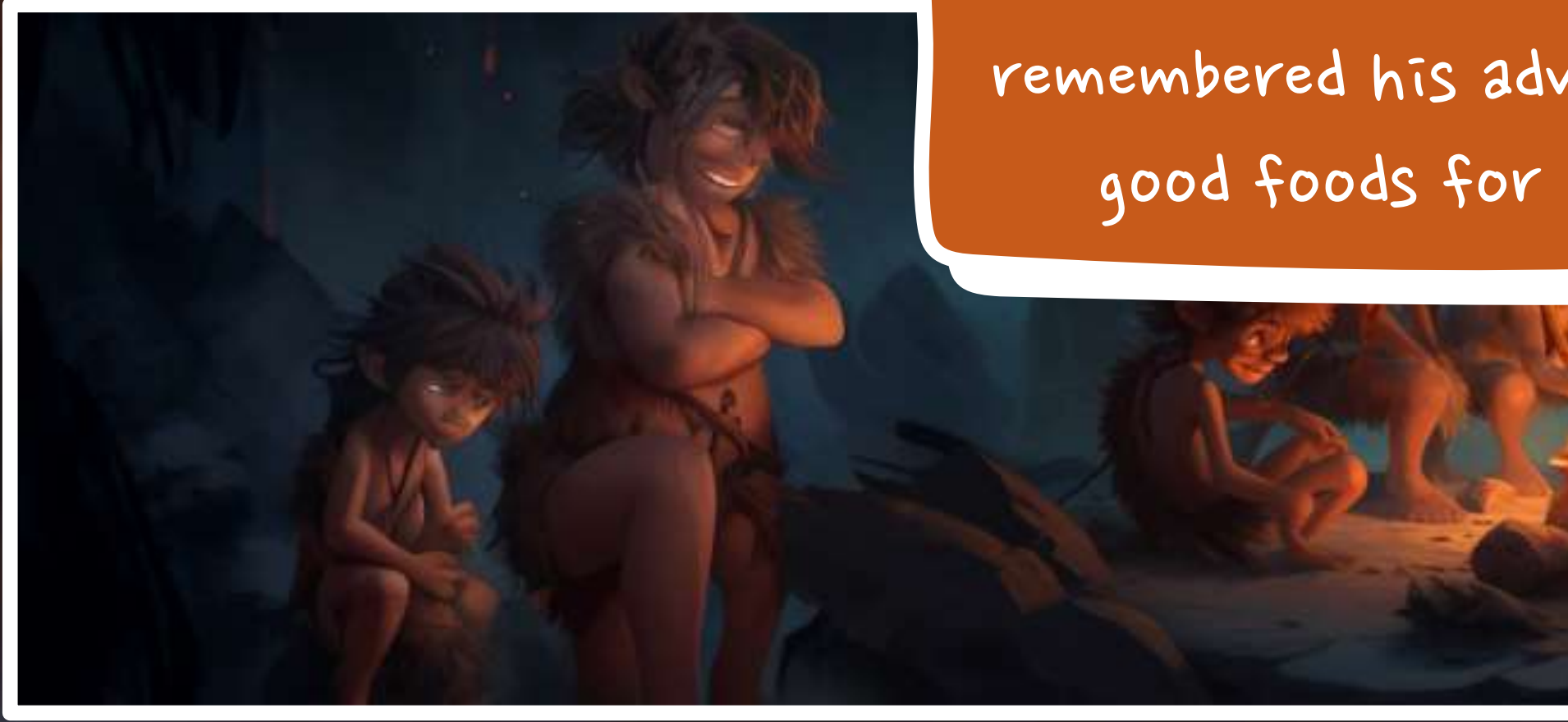



During the feast, they talked and laughed. They tried the new foods and liked them. They were thankful for Tor's hard work.
